## **New EasyJet flights to Bulgaria will boost property investment**

The recently announced addition of Bulgaria to EasyJet's network will have a significant impact on the countries property market.

EasyJet's announced new connections to seven destinations they already serve including Austria, Morocco and Portugal, but it was the addition of a brand new service to Sofia that caused most excitement.

The introduction of the three times weekly service between London Gatwick and Sofia, which commences on 6 November, reflects the airline's continued commitment to growth in Central Eastern Europe and follows the recent announcement that the airline will also enter the Romanian market as well as the introduction of routes to Gdansk in Poland. Flights to Sofia will be priced at around £28.

Bulgaria's accession to the EU in January this year has already boosted its appeal as a tourist destination and this latest improvement in accessibility will further rubber stamp its reputation as an up and coming destination for property investment.
